# West Goshen Township Planning Commission Minutes January 9, 2018

## Final Subdivision Plan(s):

### Plan for a three-lot consolidation for Jerrehian at the northwest corner of the 322 Bypass and Phoenixville Pike (Application is complete, meeting all Township ordinances)

Lou Colagreco of law firm, Riley, Riper, Hollin and Colagreco presented a three-lot consolidation plan for the purpose of selling the lots for development. The overall plan had been previously approved by the township.

A motion was made by Julie Potts to recommend approval. The motion was seconded by Jeff Lieberman and approved unanimously by the Planning Commission without further discussion. Margaret Swart (in attendance as a private citizen) voiced an objection to the vote by the commission based on the Neighborhood Investment District establishment. Julie Potts noted (and restated by Jeff Lieberman) that her concerns are a matter to be raised with the Board of Supervisors.
