COMMUNITY SURVEY RESULTS

A questionnaire was made available to West Goshen Township residents via internet and hard copy as a means to gather input on various land planning issues. A hard copy of the survey was mailed to every household in the Township. A total of 1,243 responses were received. Assuming each response represents one household, the response rate is ____%.

Two-thirds of survey respondents are age 55 and over, and there were no respondents under age 22. Approximately 45% of respondents have lived in the Township for 25 years or more, and 92% of respondents live in a single-family detached home.

The survey indicates that:

- West Goshen Township is a great place to live
- Township services, including emergency services, parks, and utilities are excellent
- The Township needs to address traffic/transportation, road condition and maintenance, and pedestrian and bicycle access and safety
- Residents want to protect water quality
- Residents strongly favor preservation of natural and historic resources
- A greater percentage of residents are not in favor of expanding opportunities for retail and commercial business than are in favor of it
- The township needs more walking and biking paths, more public open space, more and better public transportation, and more senior activities


The survey indicates that the greatest improvement needs are:

1. Please rate the quality of the following:



2. Looking to the FUTURE, the Township needs to focus more effort on:





4. Should the Township work to preserve historic resources (historic buildings, structures, and sites)?



Summary: A majority of respondents (77%) favor historic resource preservation.


5. Should the Township work to preserve natural resources (woodlands, wetlands, wildlife habitat, etc.)?


Summary: A majority of respondents (92%) favor natural resource protection.



14. What is your age group?



Summary: There are zero respondents under age 22. All other age groups are represented, with the highest response from seniors.


15. What is your association with West Goshen Township?

Answered: 1,217 Skipped: 17




Summary: There vast majority of respondents (85%) are Township residents.

16. If you are a West Goshen Township resident, what type of dwelling do you live in? Answered: 1,213 Skipped: 21




Summary: There vast majority of respondents (92%) live in a single-family detached home.
