

West Goshen Township Streets Laborer Position Open



- 🚧 Works under the immediate supervision of the Streets Superintendent.
- 🚧 Valid Pennsylvania Class A CDL or able to obtain one within six months of employment.
- 🚧 The employee frequently lifts a weight of up to 50 pounds in the carrying of stone, blacktop or bags of concrete.
- 🚧 Provides immediate response to emergencies involving hazardous conditions on the streets; emergency responses can include any of the following situations: snow removal and ice control; removal of tree or other debris from streets; placement of temporary stop signs when traffic signal is malfunctioning; set-up of road blocks on flooded streets, around downed tree on electrical wires, or street cave-ins; replacement of downed stop signs; and assisting Wastewater Treatment Department with emergency sewer line repairs.
- 🚧 Performs work zone traffic control; base work repair that includes, digging out damaged area of asphalt, performs street repair which includes cold and hot patching; performs street sign repair and installation; cuts back road banks, trims trees, and clears brush in right-of ways; cleans, maintains, and repairs storm drain catch basins.
- 🚧 Operates heavy automotive equipment such as dump truck (five yards or larger) to transport material and equipment and three-ton steel wheeled roller; operates mechanical equipment, such as a jackhammer, pneumatic compacting equipment, and hand-fed tree and brush chipper; sets safety cones and/or temporary signs around work site, and directs vehicular traffic around and through work zones to provide a safe working environment and citizen safety in the work site vicinity.
- 🚧 Inspects and checks vehicles before use in order to ensure safe operating conditions; reports mechanical defects to appropriate personnel; communicates any unsafe conditions or accidents/injuries in a timely manner to supervisor in order to facilitate prompt correction or reporting.
