Dear Mr. LaLonde:

We represent West Chester Axe, LLC, who is seeking an inter-municipal transfer of Restaurant Liquor License R-19522 from Alley Pub, Inc., 560 Lancaster Avenue, Frazer, PA 19355 to the location of 706 E. Market Street, West Chester, PA 19382 within West Goshen Township.

Pursuant to Section 461(b.3) of the Pennsylvania Liquor Code, we must first get the approval of West Goshen Township before filing an application with the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board ("PLCB") to transfer the liquor license into West Goshen Township. The Liquor Code requires us to request a hearing before the governing body of West Goshen Township for the purpose of taking public comments on the proposed transfer.

In accordance with the above referenced section of the Liquor Code, notice of the requested hearing must be published once each week for two weeks prior to the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation. Further, the first notice cannot be more than thirty days and the second notice cannot be less than seven days from the hearing date.


I would appreciate if you could schedule the public hearing before the West Goshen Township Council as soon as possible, and let me know the date, time and place of the public hearing. My client is anxious to begin the renovations and to obtain approval from the PLCB of the license transfer. The process of transferring a liquor license with the PLCB takes approximately 8 to 12 weeks and the Resolution from the receiving municipality approving the transfer is required to be attached to the application for transfer. Please also provide us with copies of all communications between the Township and our client. I enclose a sample Resolution in a form acceptable to the PLCB for your convenience.
